To promote a culture for which traffic fatalities and serious injuries are no longer acceptable through the integrated application of education, engineering, enforcement and emergency medical and trauma services.








How do we rank nationally in fatality rate for traffic deaths?

- Minnesota has the 9th lowest fatality rate in the nation.
- Minnesota ranks 6th in the nation in relation to the number of registered motor vehicles.
- Minnesota is the 3rd lowest in fatality rates per vehicle miles traveled. (2021)







Life changing alternate route








