- The All-Terrain Vehicle Association of Minnesota, Inc., first organized in 1983, is a non-profit corporation under Minnesota Statutes Chapter 317A.
- ATV MN is the State Association representing 70 ATV clubs and ATV riding families across Minnesota.
- It promotes safe, responsible ATV riding, and provides ATV clubs with the “tools” they need to build ATV trails for the riding public that are fun and sustainable, while protecting natural resources.
- Established ATV registration program and dedicated fund account, ATV Grant-in-Aid trail grant program, ATV youth safety training program
- Initiated MN DNR Volunteer Trail Ambassador Program
- Designed, constructed and maintain 1000's of miles of ATV Grant-in-Aid trails , using best practices to ensure they are safe, economically and environmentally sustainable.





- Advocate for ATV recreation focusing on the benefits of responsible riding behavior.
- We advance and foster the recognition and acceptance of ATV recreation as a fun family oriented outdoor recreational experience.
- We promote the benefits of ATV recreation as a contributor to rural economies of the State of Minnesota.
- Serve as a source of information regarding ATV recreation, clubs, activities, and significant issues regarding the sport.

ATV MN Safety Committee

- Established in 2022 to bring safety to the forefront of ATV MN membership.
- Comprised of Youth ATV Safety Instructors, MN DNR Trail Ambassadors, ATV MN Board members, Club Officers and guests from TZD and MN DNR.
- Creating a line of communication with 70 ATV MN affiliated clubs to share safety information.
- Establishing partnerships to reach riders outside of ATV MN.
