



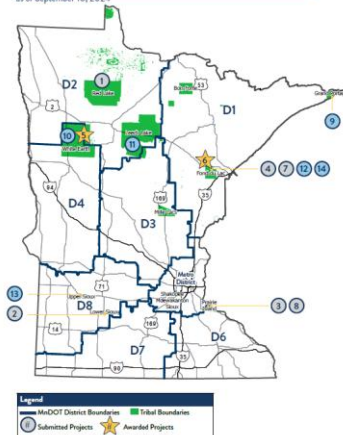

Solicitations

2024 Active Transportation (AT) and Safe Routes to School (SRTS) infrastructure Solicitations start September 23, 2024.

- Funding for eligible bicycle and pedestrian improvements
- Projects will mitigate safety hazards related to interacting with traffic, safe environments for walking and biking, connect communities/destinations to boost public health
- Must be ready for construction in 2025 or 2026
- Open to greater MN Federally Recognized Indian Tribes
